Module Details

Manu Rui is a short course that teaches you how to build dynamic and creative worships services for young people. At this course you will learn:

- An introduction to how people have worshipped in the past – in the Bible and in Anglican tradition
- The basics of Anglican worship (liturgy) What's important and what's not
- Ways that liturgy is used in your Tikanga Either in Tikanga Māori, Tikanga Pakeha, or Tikanga Pasefika
- Ways to get creative with worship services Using music, drama, or art
- How to prepare and lead a worship service for young people. Tools to help you build great worship services

To do this course, you must be at least 16 years old and be actively involved in Anglican youth ministry.

The course is residential (meaning you'll be expected to stay), and lasts from Friday dinner time through to Sunday lunch time. You will need to bring a pen and paper, sleeping gear, and toiletries. Meals will be provided.
